4. Supporting the tracking of academic and attendance data
5. Provide staff training to develop our school's RADY work
6. Contribute towards funding the following intervention programmes with a focus on literacy, numeracy, well-being support:
 - Supporting the delivery of Accelerated Reader
 - Delivery of numeracy intervention
 - The delivery of a range of programmes to support student well-being
