RE: Information for September 2026

We hope your child enjoyed our recent Year 6 Welcome Day and that you now feel well-informed about their transition to The John Frost School this September. Our **Parent Information Booklet** for 2026 has now been updated on the school website under the heading 'About Us - Transition'. This booklet contains key information about The John Frost School. Key dates for your diary:

- **Tuesday 1st September 2026** – INSET Day (school closed to all students)
- **Wednesday 2nd September 2026** – First full day for **Year 7 students only**

First Day Information – Wednesday 2nd September 2026

Students may travel to school by bus, walk, cycle, or be dropped off by a family member. They should arrive by **8:30am**. If cycling, students must wear a helmet and bring a lock to secure their bike in the designated bike park in front of the Jones Building.

The school day ends at **3:20pm**, and students may return home using the same travel options.

Students should attend in full school uniform. The programme for the day will include:

- Activities with form tutors
- Biometric scanning for canteen access
- Assembly with the Headteacher and Assistant Headteacher
- Introduction to Accelerated Reader and Timetables for Life
- A Freshers' Fair showcasing a wide range of extra-curricular activities

Students will receive their timetables on Wednesday or Thursday morning. These will be clearly explained to them during sessions with their form tutors. Parents will be able to view their child's timetable, academic progress, and school reports via the **SIMS Parent App**. Further information will be shared during the first half term.

The **Parent Calendar** will also be updated on our website by September, providing a full overview of school events throughout the year.

ParentPay and School Canteen

ParentPay activation letters will be sent at the start of term. We encourage you to register promptly so your child can purchase food from the canteen and participate in school trips and visits. More details are available in the Parent Information Booklet.

Please note that on **Wednesday 2nd September 2026**, the canteen will offer a limited menu. We recommend that students bring a **packed lunch, snacks, and drinks** for the day.
